

Madagascar: Move It! Installation Guide

Hardware and Software Requirements

Hardware

The following hardware is a minimum specification to run Madagascar: Move It! on a device:

- A 4th generation (or later) Intel® Core™ processor
- 2GB free hard disk space
- An Intel® RealSense™ 3D Camera F200 (system-integrated or peripheral version)
- Graphics Processing Unit
 - Minimum: Intel 5x series GPU
 - Recommend: Dedicated NVidia or ATI Graphics card

Software

Currently, the following software is required on the device before Madagascar: Move It! is installed:

- Microsoft Windows* 8.1 OS 64-bit Desktop Mode
- Intel RealSense Drivers – currently, we use the following:
 - Depth Camera Manager (DCM) v1.3.x
 - Depth Camera Driver
 - RGB Camera Driver
 - 3D Camera Virtual Driver

We are also testing the following for compatibility with our application:

- Microsoft Windows* 10 Pro Insider Preview Build #10074 OS 64-bit Desktop Mode.

Installer Instructions

To install on your system:

1. Make sure that your device complies with all the above hardware and software requirements.
2. Ensure that the RealSense Depth Camera Manager (DCM) v1.3.x drivers are installed on the system, this should be done when the RS F200 camera is installed.
3. Download the installer package (link above) to a directory on your device.
4. Run the installer by double clicking on it and follow the instructions onscreen.
5. This will install the application on your device and add a desktop icon.
6. Click this desktop icon to run the application.
